

CLINIC/MEDICATIONS

- A student must have a pass from the teacher to enter the clinic. Students will remain in the clinic no longer than 15 minutes. They must go back to class or go home after that time.
 - All medication must be turned into the school clinic and/or the administration immediately upon arrival for proper locked storage in the prescription's original container. **No** medication (including any over the counter medication, i.e. Tylenol, aspirin, etc.) can be possessed, distributed, or used on the school campus and/or at school functions by any student without authorization or approval by the school administration.
 - **Failure to comply is a violation of school board policy and possible recommendation for expulsion.**

- In order for medication to be administered by school personnel, **it must be prescribed by a physician and parental permission and directions must be given to the school.**
 - If a student needs to check out from the clinic, he/she will do so from the attendance office.
